

The Division of Facilities Construction and Management

The Division of Facilities Construction and Management (DFCM) is the building manager for all Utah state owned facilities and is responsible for all aspects of construction and maintenance of state buildings.

The DFCM use their videoconferencing system to hold construction meetings that would otherwise require people to travel around the state. The room is used several times a week for construction and project management meetings for projects that are more than 2 hours away. The DFCM can even tour remote construction sites and see areas of concern when the remote site uses the Tandberg FieldView™ camera. This hand-held, wireless video conferencing camera shares video up to 2.5Mbps SIP. Enabled with two-way voice capability, the FieldView camera operator simply wears a headset to communicate with the team at DFCM while relaying the video.

The DFCM audio visual system is equipped with multiple inputs, microphones and laptop inputs so that anyone in the meeting can share their computer content on the two wall mounted displays panels or over the videoconferencing system. The room is also equipped with an assisted listening equipment. A Biamp Audia Flex controls audio and echo cancellation and mixes all of the microphones. While the Extron Crosspoint controls the routing of the various table and video inputs to the videoconferencing system and dual displays. The entire system is controlled via a AMX tabletop touchpanel and control system to allow user friendly operation of the system. The AV equipment is housed in two equipment racks located in a cabinet within the room. The AV system automatically powers down at night.
