The paneled walls, leather chairs and unique lighting already gave Northwest Airlines' executive boardroom a distinguished appearance. However the boardroom needed to be updated with high-tech communication equipment to handle more modern presentations and audio conferences without changing the elegance of the room.

The audio-visual room is located behind the wall-mounted rear projection screen. Housed in this room, a Proxima LCD projector is inverted on a ceiling mount and projected via a mirror system on to the screen. Elsewhere in the room and concealed behind a panel, the custom rack contains a VCR, DVD player and a slideto-video converter. All images are channeled through the projector for viewing on the screen.

Other features include numerous computer inputs for multiple presenters located around the table and microphones that are mounted around the room recessed and virtually invisible within the ceiling. Adding to the simplicity of the system, presenters can easily control all elements of the presentation, lighting and audio conferencing systems from the wireless touchscreen panel.
